

## Trainee Information System: A system to manage trainee education and learning



### This communication is directed at Trusts who currently use Intrepid systems

Health Education England has been developing information systems that will replace Intrepid and other systems in use, and over the last two years we have been setting up the capability to do just. We are aiming to release a second major release called TIS Core Services to HEE staff in the next few weeks.


Our original plan was to replace Trust Intrepid with TIS from April 2018 and we have a Trust portal in development that will streamline and improve how we share and work with our Trusts. However, the delivery of this portal is delayed. We are therefore reviewing our timelines and have been working with Hicom Technology, the supplier of Intrepid, to extend the use of Intrepid in Trusts while the Trust portal is completed.

This delay means that we are seeking to maintain as much of the status quo with our Trusts where we have given them access, both to Intrepid V10 (the core system) and to a range of modules where these are in use.

When we are in a position to implement the Trust portal that will access the TIS Core Services, alongside a new system of data transfer we will start a transition project. It is likely that this will happen in the next three to six months.

For those Trusts which have implemented the ESR interface we remain optimistic that the project to transition to TIS will be seamless and happen before April. Joint ESR/HEE communications will continue to be made to Trust ESR contacts.

Trusts need to be aware that TIS will be released as a system to manage trainees and associated trainers/supervisors, so if you use Intrepid to record other groups then this will not be transferred into TIS, when Trusts receive TIS. Over time it is HEE's intention to review with our Trusts what other groups could be recorded on TIS. If you are impacted by this change then you will need to make provision and we will seek to support where feasible and when asked.
