# Medical Education Management Pathway Professional Practice MSc

The University of Kent's Global and Lifelong Learning Department offers the opportunity for those involved in the administration, coordination and facilitation of medical education in medical education centres and other settings to obtain a Master's level qualification relevant to their professional practice.

### About the course

- Suitable for both non-clinical and clinical staff at all levels of their career who are involved in the management of medical education
- Three years part-time study to complete the MSc
- Modular online blended delivery at weekends (including Fridays)

# Course structure, content and delivery

All students on the MSc Professional Practice Medical Education Management pathway take the following core modules:

### Stage 1 (PgCert)

Online induction: Mon 22 Sep 2025

### Evidence based practice - 30 credits

- Weekend 1: Fri 26 Sun 28 Sep 2025
- Weekend 2: Fri 7 Sat 8 (Sun 9 TBC) Nov 2025

### Introduction to Medical Education Management – 30 credits

- Weekend 1: Fri 16 Sun 18 Jan 2026
- Weekend 2: Fri 13 Sat 14 (Sun 15 TBC)
   March 2026

### Research skills - 30 credits

## Work-related project and dissertation - 60 credits

 Autumn term 2027 – Summer term 2028 (dates to be confirmed in spring 2027)

### Teaching and assessment

Teaching is structured around a series of extended taught weekends (on average four weekends a year) and delivery will be online, blended synchronous and asynchronous sessions. (Students will be required to have access to equipment necessary for online study.)

Timings: Friday-Sunday 09:00-17:00 (plus induction prior to the first module)

You will be asked to undertake preparatory module reading and associated tasks, prepare and deliver presentations and carry out work-based investigations.

This course is 100% coursework assessed.

### **Fees**

Annual fees for 2025/2026 are £3,400 and are subject to incremental rises. Postgraduate student loans for Master's degrees are available (subject to eligibility criteria).


